Recording Services Unavailable August 25 and 26 in Preparation for New Official Records System

The Clerk of the Circuit Court & Comptroller, Palm Beach County is launching a new Official Records system at the end of August. In order to implement the new system, the Clerk's office must temporarily pause recording services.

In-Person Services

In-person recording of documents at all Clerk locations in Palm Beach County will be unavailable starting at noon on Thursday, August 25 and will remain unavailable all day on Friday, August 26.

Copy requests will also be limited.

eRecording

Documents submitted for eRecording after noon on Wednesday, August 24, will be held until the new system is up. Documents will be recorded in the order received once service is restored on Monday, August 29.

this process. Uncertified, watermarked copies of documents may be printed for free through the website.

Court records searches, eFiling of court case documents and online ordering of **certified copies of court documents** will operate as normal. For in-person ordering of copies of court documents on August 25 and 26, customers should visit the appropriate court department rather than the Clerk's Records Service Center.
