I am writing in support of the request appropriated this year by the Florida House and Senate for Career and Technical Education scholarships for students in Belle Glade at our West Technical Education Center. (LFIR #1037)

This funding assists citizens (living in one of the highest poverty areas in our state) to acquire critically-needed job skills and gain access to immediate career opportunities. This will lead to dependable, sustainable, year-round employment where few opportunities exist.

I am a member of the Glades Career Readiness Roundtable – a consortium comprising area business & civic leaders, Chamber of Commerce members, and economic forces such as Career Source and the Business Development Board. We meet monthly to strategize vocational training opportunities in order to meet the current and pressing needs of area employers.

Belle Glade is surrounded by fertile farmland and is, first and foremost, an agricultural community.
