"Executive function" is a construct used to describe repertoires critical to many aspects of life. It is sometimes described as "the management system of the brain". Executive function is divided into 3 broad domains: working memory. cognitive flexibility, and inhibitory control. When a student apparently lacks one of these repertoires, it is common to introduce a support, such as visual reminders. While potentially part of the solution, these supports are not magic! In this presentation, we will focus primarily on practical strategies for teaching executive function skills. While these skills usually continue to develop during adolescence, the foundations of these skills can be taught much sooner. Click here to register.
