

## Plant Pathology Workshop for Middle School and High School Teachers

## Don't Get Caught with Your Plants Down!







## The FREE workshop will be a combination of lectures and activity demonstrations and field tours.

This is the second annual workshop provided by the University of Florida, IFAS for middle school and high school teachers located throughout the state. This year's program was developed by the Department of Plant Pathology using resources available from the American Phytopathological Society. Plant Pathology is a STEM topic that includes biology, microbiology and chemistry. Florida's warm temperate and sub-tropical environments are wonderful for growing plants (forestry, agriculture and ornamentals) and the pathogens that infect these plants. The many ports of entry also make Florida vulnerable to new, invasive plant pathogens. Teachers will be exposed to the basics of plant pathology through lectures and demonstrations that can be used in the classroom. Materials will be provided in person and available on a website. **The workshop is free, with lunch provided.**
