ABOUT US

Rebel Recovery Florida is an accredited low barrier recovery community organization that provides recovery support services, education, and advocacy to people



impacted by drug use and those living with or at risk of infectious disease. From our Board of Directors to

our staff, our organization was founded and continues to be led by people with direct lived experience with drug use and recovery.

Headquartered in Palm Beach County, all of our programs and services are free and offer personcentered, participant-driven support.

REBEL CLUB

Rebel operates the county's only national peer accredited recovery community center. This is a safe space for anyone impacted by drugs. It is a judgement-free zone where you met with compassion and will be treated with dignity. Events and pro-



social programs offer opportunities for the recovery community to come together and build resiliency.

The 2019 Recovery Science Research Collaborative's consensus definition of recovery states:

"Recovery is an individualized, intentional, dynamic, and relational process involving sustained efforts to improve wellness."

WHAT IS CERTIFIED RECOVERY PEER SUPPORT?

Recovery is about connection.

As we grow in our connection to each other and to the world at large, we begin to move in a positive direction.

Peer Support is aimed at guiding people in or seeking recovery through this process of change towards an increased quality of life.

Using this empowering support to develop resiliency includes increased self-sufficiency and improved quality of life.



According to the working definition from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMSHA),

Recovery is "a process of change through which individuals improve their health and wellness, live a self-directed life, and strive to reach their full potential."

PEER SERVICES

We built a program guided by the belief that peer support services should reflect the personal, individualized nature of recovery,

not our opinions. We work with you to overcome the barriers you face to achieve sustained wellness.



OVERDOSE RESPONSE AND PREVENTION

Rebel peer staff connect directly with participants who have experienced a non-lethal overdose to help them navigate potential support services to prevent future overdose events.

Our community education program RADD includes training for overdose prevention and response, certified instruction for Narcan use and

emergency response, Safety First: Real Drug Education for Teens, and Narcan distribution programs to increase naloxone saturation.



PUBLIC HEALTH

Programs improve health outcomes through risk-reduction and targeted support for vulnerable populations. Harm reduction services and traumainformed practices are applied during all engagements. Community health workers extend the reach of services. FLASH is the county mobile syringe and health services unit. It offers one-to-one exchange services.

Wound care, prevention education, screening and linkage to health services and resources reduce infectious disease.
