ELIGIBILITY

- ➤ Must be a GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR IN 2023.
- > Ability to relate to and work with people of all ages.
- > Academic aptitude and achievement.
- > Commitment to service, with special interest in teaching children and youth.
- > Economic need
- ➤ Emphasis is placed on SAT and/or ACT scores. The minimum score for SAT is 1,000 or above (Reading and Math sections) or ACT is 22 or above.
- > Participation and leadership in school and community activities.
- > Poise and ability to communicate effectively.
- > There is no restriction as to sex, race, religion, national origin, or size of school. FREF adheres to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

CONDITIONS

A scholarship is awarded to a high school graduating senior for one year and can be renewed for a maximum of four years of college if the student maintains a satisfactory level of achievement. Satisfactory achievement is defined as a 2.0 grade point average with no failing grade in any subject.

Scholarship recipients may attend any accredited Florida public or private community college, four-year college or university, provided that their programs are consistent with the goal of becoming a qualified teacher
