Click here to Apply to our program today! We're seeking your support to recruit (50) 9th-grade male students into our Take Stock in Children program. We are also recruiting male mentors to guide them. Educational programs are witnessing disparities among male minority students, particularly in higher education. Recent studies highlight the challenges faced by minority males, including limited access to resources, lack of role models, and systemic barriers perpetuating inequality.

Currently, our program serves 500 high school students, with only a 30% male ratio. Through our Male Recruitment Initiative, we aim to achieve a more balanced representation of male and female students. By actively enrolling more male students and providing targeted support and scholarships, we strive to create an inclusive environment that benefits all participants and empowers students to overcome obstacles and achieve their full potential.
