Council Update: 800 fewer PBC children waiting for mentors

Since 2012, aggressive recruitment efforts by United Way of Palm Beach County's Mentor Center has led to more local mentor-mentee matches - and 800 fewer children waiting for a mentor. However despite its efforts to recruit more mentors, especially male mentors of color, more than 1,200 Palm Beach County children remain on the wait list.
