Health Care District Offers Free, Walk-up Pediatric and Adult COVID-19 Vaccines

West Palm Beach, FL – Free adult and pediatric doses of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccines for individuals as young as five years of age are available at Health Care District of Palm Beach County mobile clinic sites countywide. Wait times are minimal for vaccinations outside the Health Care District’s Lantana Clinic at 1250 Southwinds Drive, which is open weekdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The Lantana site is closed Friday, December 24th and Friday, December 31st.

The Health Care District continues its partnership with the [School District of Palm Beach County](#) to expand access to COVID-19 vaccinations, providing over 1,500 shots at School District sites since November 4th. Children ages 5 through 17 must be with a parent or guardian to be vaccinated. No appointment is necessary. The pediatric dose for children ages 5 to 11 is one-third the strength of the vaccine formulated for those ages 12 and older. It’s authorized by the [FDA](#) and approved by the [CDC](#), which reports that COVID-19 is the eighth-leading cause of death among children ages 5 to 11.

Boosters of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine are also available to individuals 18 years and older per U.S. [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\) guidelines](#). Those interested in receiving a booster shot should bring their COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card with them so a provider can fill in the information about the booster dose. To date, the Health Care District has provided over 223,000 COVID-19 vaccinations countywide and will be at the following sites this month:
