The Drowning Prevention Coalition provides free land based Water Safety presentations to schools, businesses and organizations with the mission to prevent drowning, non-fatal drowning and other water-related incidents by educating residents on water safety and basic rescue techniques. The DPC also provides vouchers that allow children ages 2 to 12 that qualify to take free or reduced cost swim lessons at participating pools. There are also a limited number of swim vouchers for adults over the age of 50 that do not know how to swim.

The "ABCD's of Water Safety" curriculum includes such information as the importance of adult supervision, beaches, boating, and backyard safety as well as canal and drain safety with the use of props to make the presentation as interactive as possible. Additional topics covered will be information regarding our free and reduced cost swim lesson voucher program.
