## Registration

Rainbow Trails is a weekend grief camp for children ages 6-17 and is provided at no charge. For over 25 years this incredible camp has changed lives and helped grieving children cope with the recent loss of their loved ones. While camp has a serious purpose, it also includes a lot of fun activities including swimming, singing, crafts and the great outdoors.

Volunteers are an important part of our camp. Working under the direction of our professional team, adults aged 18 and over can apply to help at camp. Guidance and training are provided. Volunteers help in many areas including:

- chaperone/buddy/room monitor
- recreation activities
- pre-and post-camp registraion and reception
- on-site medication/first aid nurses
- kitchen staff
- safety and security

Roles are assigned to volunteers based on need and experience. Some camp volunteer roles require two overnight stays; others require only day/evening participation on the weekend. All camp volunteers must attend an orientation and training session(s) provided by Hope's camp director and bereavement counselors (dinner is served during sessions) prior to camp.
