# CONCERNED ABOUT A FAMILY MEMBER OR FRIEND?



## Are they thinking about suicide?

Do they:

- Talk about wanting to die
- Feel trapped or in unbearable pain
- Worry about being a burden to others
- Feel hopeless or feel they have no reason to live
- Withdraw or isolate themselves
- Increase the use of alcohol or drugs
- Feel anxious or agitated; behave recklessly
- Show rage or talking about seeking revenge
- Have extreme mood swings

## HELP SAVE A LIFE

- Ask directly if they are thinking about suicide and listen.
- Putting time and distance between a person thinking about suicide and a gun may save a life.
- Offer to store a firearm for your loved one until they are feeling well.
- Encourage them to keep their firearm locked and unloaded.
